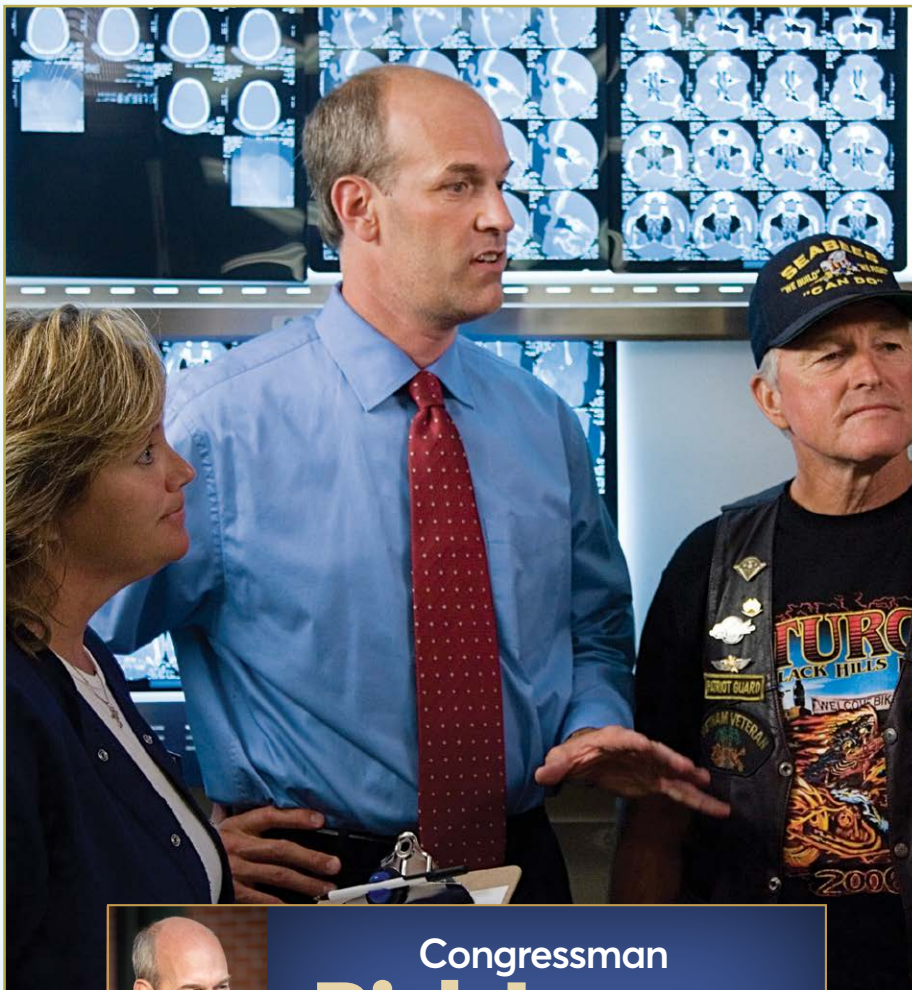

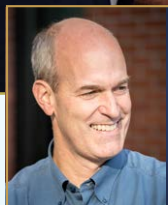
Better Access to Care

Saved Whidbey Island Nutrition Office Serving Military Families
